# ANNUAL PARISH MEETING CHAIR'S REPORT ON COUNCIL ACTIVITIES 2021-2022

### **Activities**;

The Parish Council met 4 times in 2021/22.

#### The main activities and issues are as follows:

- i) Street Cleaning Partnership; agreement was made with BDC to receive additional funds for litter picking, maintenance of the playing field, pond and other amenities in the village.
- ii) Planning Applications; several were received during this year, no objections were noted by the Council. The Council created a Planning Advisory Committee comprising three council members supported by the clerk.
- iii) Verge cutting; the parish clerk administered the contracts in accordance with the schedule as laid down by E.C.C. Highways Dept.
- iv) The contract for cutting the cemetery grass and the village hall grass continued to be fulfilled by a village resident with positive feedback received.
- v) The Council decided to join the Parish Paths Partnership Scheme.
- vi) The Council made a donation of £600 to the Belchamp Walter Parochial Church restricted to the fabric of the church.
- vii) The Council applied for and was awarded a Councillor's Community Grant of £350 which will go towards the cost of a new bench.
- viii) Ms Sara Perez resigned from the Council. The Council thanks her for her service
- ix) The Council thanks Mr Colin Doman for performing the independent review of the financial report

## Financial Report;

i) Balances Community Account at 31 March 2022 was £ 3364.55
Reserve Account £ 4061.10

Total Net Balances at year end £ 7,425.65

Included in the above is £ 122 for the Playing Field Restricted Fund

ii) The budget for 2022/2023 was set to result in zero increase in the parish precept paid by each household
