Gourmet Meal

On Saturday 25th February 30 people experienced an evening of culinary delights. After a glass of prosecco, olives and a selection of nuts on arrival diners were treated to a six-course meal starting with Amuse-Bouche - Blue cheese & pear pikelet, beef & horseradish choux bun, devilled quail's egg with chorizo. Then there was a choice of two soups – Thai chicken, ginger and coconut or French Onion with a cheese crouton. The entrée was - Matjes herring on a celeriac remoulade, beetroot, apple, pickled onion & a horseradish & herb cream, or the Belchamp Walter Salad – Mixed leaves, cucumber, Pancetta cubes, avocado, sundried tomatoes, blue cheese, toasted pine nuts & a balsamic vinaigrette. The main event - Chicken & tarragon, served with Dauphinoise Potatoes, green beans & Carrots. A slight rest with the Entremets – a watermelon sorbet, followed by a choice of desserts – Sticky toffee pudding with home made vanilla ice cream, or Tarte au citron with raspberries. The meal was finished with coffee or teas and petits fours.

The food was delicious as was the atmosphere and the music. Huge thanks are due all those who cooked, served, washed up and played music to make this such a special event. In addition, the event raised much needed funds to maintain our lovely Victorian village hall.
