Annual Meeting

The Belchamp Walter Parochial Parish Council (PCC) Annual Meeting was held on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March at 7:00pm in the village hall. The PCC members were elected and they are David Gerrard, Polly Gerrard, Helen Krelle, Terry Raybould, Martin Runnacles, Louise Scott, Pete Scott and Monika Shepherd.

### Easter Day

Come and join the dawn service at the church on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> April. Rise early and at 05:50, gather around the fire to witness the sunrise. There will be song and praise followed by a short service in the church after which breakfast will be served.

## Church Building

In the last week Arte Conservation conducted a survey of the wall paintings in the church. The paintings have also been 'museum cleaned.' The survey will give the PCC a much needed base line on the condition of the paintings so that we know what needs to be done to preserve for future generations. The cost of this work will be funded by a grant and funds raised by the FOBWC.

The church roof and porch are in need of repair. The tower, Nave and Porch roofs need maintenance and repair work. Quotes received for the three sections are approximately £20,000. Five grant applications are in to help fund this and we have been advised of £8,000 towards the project from Friends of Essex Churches Trust. As this is less than half of what is needed, we are hoping the other grant bodies we have approached will be equally as generous.
