#### **3. Matter Arising**

##### *(a) Defibrillator*

Ms Munro reported that contacted Community Heart Beat to discuss the defibrillator and given the Village Hall is a listed building had contacted Braintree Planning Department to obtain views on installing the defibrillator on the outside wall. The preliminary view of the Planning Department indicated that they would likely not approve such an installation because it would be highly visible.

The Parish Council considered alternatives and concluded that it could be installed in the hallway of the village hall. The outside door would need to be unlocked and the lock on the inside door might need to be upgraded.

The Parish Council asked the clerk to communicate the decision to the Village Hall Committee

##### *(b) Village Hall Wall*

Ms Munro reported that Colin Smith was preparing a quotation for repairs to the Village Hall Wall based on taking down the front wall, replacing the footings and then rebuilding and using salvaged bricks to repair the side walls.
